INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES 2025-2026



METHOD 1 - AMI DAY

AMI REMOTE LEARNING

Alternative methods of Instruction (AMI) day is when we teach and work from home due to weather-related events. Students will participate in:

Synchronous learning:

Teachers and students are online for instruction or

Asynchronous learning:

Students complete online assignments or take-home assignments independently.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR PARENT(S) / STUDENT(S)?

- Students will not report to school.
- Students will receive AMI Day Instruction.

* Students must complete and submit their AMI assignments by the first day of school after the AMI day to be marked as present for that day.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR STAFF?

- School-based staff may work remotely.
- Principal, VP may work remotely or in-person.
- District Office staff report in-person
- Custodial staff report to work

METHOD 2 - SNOW DAY

SNOW DAY

A traditional snow day is when we call off school due to inclement weather.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR PARENT(S) / STUDENT(S)?

NO SCHOOL

- Students will **NOT** report to school.
- Students will **NOT** report to school.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR STAFF?

- No certified staff or instructional-classified staff report to work.
- Principal, VP work remotely.
- 12-month school-based staff and District Office Staff work remotely.
- Custodial staff report to work

METHOD 3 - EMERGENCY DAY

SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS

The Superintendent may declare an "Emergency Day" when weather conditions are unsafe for travel.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR PARENT(S) / STUDENT(S)?

NO SCHOOL

- Students will **NOT** report to school.
- Students will **NOT** report to school.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR STAFF?

- School-based staff do not report to work.
- Principal and VP work remotely.
- 12-month staff and District Office Staff work remotely. Core hours are 9AM - 3PM.
- Custodial staff report to work
